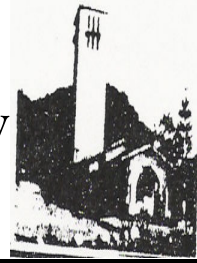

FUNERAL: Funeral arrangements are made with the cooperation of the mortuary and St. Michael. It is customary to call the Rectory **before completing arrangements.**

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: For those who suffer from serious illness or before surgery, call the Rectory Office.

HOMEBOUND: For the aged, sick or homebound who wishes to receive Holy Eucharist, call the Rectory Office or Priscilla Tampon at 293-2753.

WANT MARRIAGE BLESSED? Highly recommended if marriage not celebrated in the Church. Call the Rectory office or see the priest.

In today's Gospel the transfigured Jesus converses with Moses and Elijah about his exodus to take place in Jerusalem. Our Lenten journey to baptism or the renewal of our baptism is meant to be a prayerful entering into Christ's paschal mystery, an exodus to glory that begins *now* in our liturgical worship, in our Eucharist today, and continues through our apostolic witness in the world. 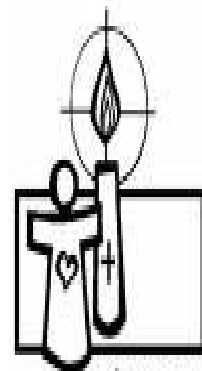

Is God calling you to serve as a Eucharistic Minister? If so, listen to the call and plan to attend a training session on:

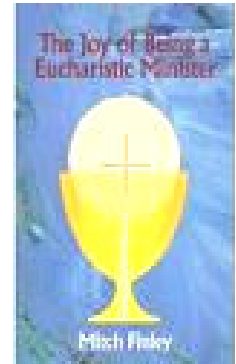

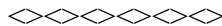

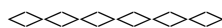
FILIPINO CATHOLIC CLUB NEWS

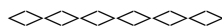

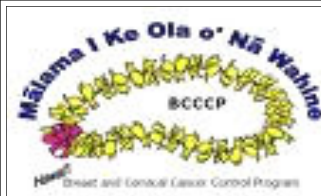
Our candidate this year is **Brianne Baysa**, granddaughter of Francis and Dolly Baysa and daughter of Nathan Baysa.
