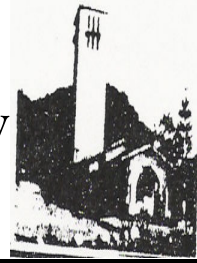

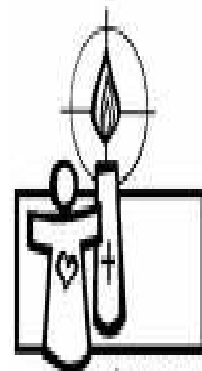

Mrs. Jayne Mondoy & Mr. Robert Mondoy:

Jayne was born and raised in Honolulu and is a graduate of Sacred Hearts Academy. She attended college on the mainland and returned to earn a Master's Degree from Chaminade. Jayne is Director of Religious Education for the Diocese of Honolulu. She holds a Master's Degree in Pastoral Leadership, is actively involved in the Marianist family program and is an on-line facilitator for the University of Dayton's Pastoral Institute. She has written and presented for national organizations including the Liturgical Ministry (Liturgical Press) and the National Catholic Educational Association. She and her husband Tom have a daughter, Catherine, who is currently studying at the University of San Francisco.

Robert was born and raised on Moloka'i. He holds a Master's Degree in Music Composition and Pedagogy from San Francisco State University. He is a professional musician and composer. He gives private piano lessons, is the Liturgical musician for St. John Vianney Parish and is the diocesan liturgical music consultant. His music compositions and piano performances are well known throughout the diocese.

Jayne's topic is *Evening Song and Celebration*. She will be accompanied by her brother-in-law Robert during her presentation. She will speak of the music we sing in the liturgy and how it holds the potential to shape the way we live and see the world. It will be a joyful time of Scripture-inspired song and prayer that calls us to lives rooted in the Gospel. Jayne is a woman of enthusiasm; Robert is a musician fantastic. What a wonderful way to end our day!

She is now located in Waialua 'on the hill' with three other Sisters and seven Monks. She is busy on a daily basis with retreats, counseling, inner healing, seminars and parish missions.
