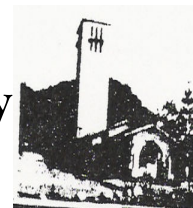

WHAT ARE THE SYMPTOMS OF SWINE FLU IN HUMANS?

The symptoms of swine flu in people are similar to the symptoms of regular human seasonal influenza and include fever, lethargy (abnormal drowsiness), lack of appetite and coughing. Some people with swine flu also have reported runny nose, sore throat, nausea, vomiting and diarrhea. **Sneeze and cough into a Kleenex or your sleeve. WASH YOUR HANDS!**

Try to stay in good general health. Get plenty of sleep, be physically active, manage your stress, drink plenty of fluids, and eat nutritious food.
