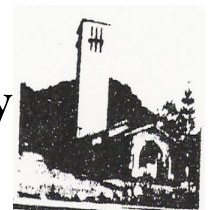

DAMIEN PRINT FOR SALE

Celebrated Big Island artist Dietrich Varez has created a new block print of Father Damien celebrating his canonization on October 11, 2009 in Rome. The artwork, rich in detail and symbolism in typical Varez fashion, shows angels presenting the missionary to Molokai with a halo made of maile. The reproductions are 11”x14”, brown ink printed on light tan paper.



Varez has given Bishop Larry Silva permission to produce the image and offer reproductions for sale. Proceeds from the sale of the reproductions will help pay for Damien canonization-related expenses in Hawaii including the travel costs for Kalaupapa patients who want to attend the ceremonies in Belgium and Rome.
