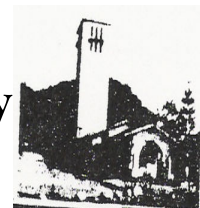

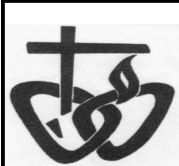

Father Mark J. Gantley, JCL, judicial vicar and director of canonical affairs for the Diocese of Honolulu for the past two years, was ordained a priest of the Diocese of Syracuse on June 8, 1991. After a few years of ordination, he was sent back to school to earn a degree in canon law in 1998. In addition to parish ministry, he served as a judge on the Tribunal in Syracuse before coming to Hawaii as a priest “on loan”. He also served for six years on loan to the Diocese of Las Vegas.

Possible questions for discussion:


1. In what ways does our society today attempt to rewrite the contract of marriage, contrary to the design of God?
2. Because marriage between the baptized is a sacrament, what difference does it make for two Christians to have Christ as a part of the married life?
