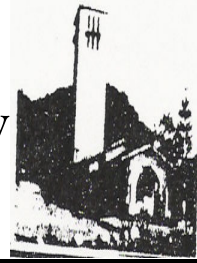

HB444 IS VETOED.... The Hawai'i Family Forum and the Hawai'i Catholic Conference are grateful for Gov. Linda Lingle's veto of HB444. Her decision came after a thoughtful and balanced study of the bill and its consequences and we are convinced she has come to the proper and only conclusion that will best serve the people of Hawai'i. Her veto affirms the will of Hawai'i citizens. In 1998, 70% of Hawaii voters ratified a constitutional amendment limiting marriage to one man or one woman. A 2009 survey by SMS Research Hawai'i found that 66% agreed with that vote more than a decade ago.

Hawai'i Family Forum and the Hawai'i Catholic Conference thank the thousands of people who took action to express their beliefs and stood strong in support of traditional family values and the definition of marriage as being limited to one man and one woman.
