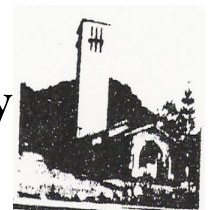

Why did God give us marriage and what does it signify? Why should engagement come before marriage...come before sexual intimacy...come before children? What are the essentials of marriage? What makes a marriage valid or invalid? Is separation accepted? Is divorce? What is annulment? What are the grounds for a declaration of annulment? How is our society attempting to rewrite the contract of marriage?

FATHER DAMIEN'S CANONIZATION

I am grateful to all the members of the Father Damien/Mother Marianne Commission of the Diocese and many others who have worked so hard to prepare for the celebration of Father Damien's canonization on October 11, 2009. I am particularly grateful to Deacon Wally Mitsui for becoming the coordinator of the events.



I want to call several items to your attention:

- www.fatherdamien.com is a new website with a wealth of information you can use for catechesis on Father Damien; for a list of celebrations, both in Belgium and Rome, and here in Hawaii; for Father Damien books and memorabilia; and for links to other sites pertinent to the life of Father Damien and his legacy.
- I ask all the parishes, missions, and oratories in the Diocese of Honolulu to celebrate the Mass in honor of Father Damien on the day of his canonization, October 11, and even at the Saturday Vigil Masses on October 10. The readings will be those of the 28th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year B. The gospel of the Rich Young Man is quite appropriate. The Mass prayers can be found on the website.
- The canonization will take place on Sunday, October 11, at 10:00 AM in Rome, which will be Saturday, October 10, at 10:00 PM in Hawaii. It will be telecast live on EWTN and will be preceded by a one-hour documentary on Oceanic Cable 16, beginning at 9:00 PM. We encourage parishes, youth groups, and others to plan for a communal viewing of the event in parish halls or wherever a big-screen TV can be set up. The documentary will be replayed on Sunday, October 11, at 1:00 PM Hawaii Time, and the canonization will be replayed the same day at 2:00 PM.

We encourage you to plan ahead to take best advantage off this unique opportunity.

SACRED HEART SOCIETY PLANS NOVENA

Nine-day evening novena prayer and rosary devotion to the Sacred Hearts, June 10 through June 18, 6:30 PM at the residence of our present Hermana, 2008, Bonnie Sales. Then, on Friday, June 19 at 6:30 PM the Feast Day of the Sacred Heart of Jesus will be celebrated in St. Michael Church. At that time, the statue of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus & Mary will be presented to the Hermana 2009—Marina Erice.

The Hermana (sponsor) keeps the statue at her home during her one-year reign and is also responsible in planning the activities of the organization.

Following the Mass, there will be a potluck at the parish hall. All parishioners are cordially invited to join in the celebration of prayers, fun, and food.
