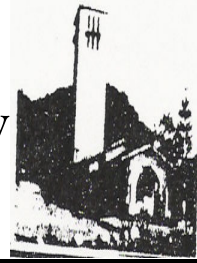

A screening clinic will be held to identify children in Hawaii who can benefit from the expert orthopaedic and burn care provided at Shriners Hospitals.
