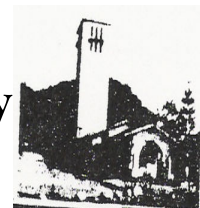

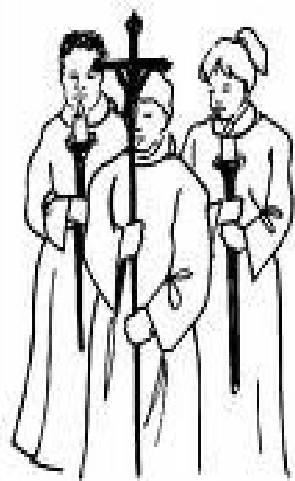

- Have a repair that needs to be done at home?

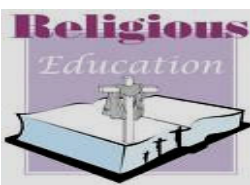
We may be able to help you. Please call the rectory office to let us know how we can assist you.
