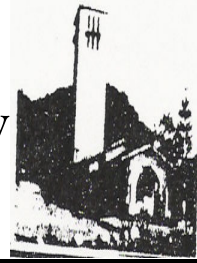

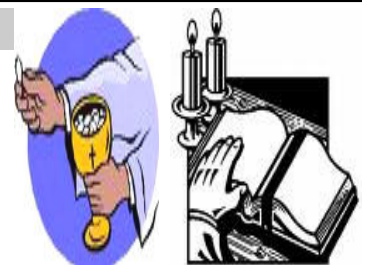

In conjunction with Veterans' Day, our topic this month will be **A JUST WAR**. The presentation will be given by CDR Patrick McCormick, Military Chaplain at the Marine Corp Base in Kaneohe. Fr. Pat is a marvelous teacher and we will all learn a great deal from his knowledge and wealth of experience.

Fr. Pat was born in Erie, Pa, attended the University of Notre Dame, then lived at the North American Seminary in Rome while studying at the Gregorian University and was ordained in Rome on December 20, 1968. He was then a priest of the Diocese of Atlanta, GA. In addition he was a faculty member and director of liturgy at the North American College Seminary in Rome and studied liturgy at San Anselmo's University in Rome.

In 1990, Fr. Pat became a Navy Chaplain. He has been stationed at the LaMaddalena, Italy subbase, USS Constellation, San Diego, Navy Weapons Station, China Lake, CA, Naval Station Yokosuka, Japan, Marine Air Station, Iwakuni, Japan, and Naval Station Pearl Harbor Chaplain. He returned this summer from Combined Security Transition Command, Afghanistan: Kabul. So he has a wealth of knowledge and experience to share with us!

As we commemorate our Veterans, let us also learn more about the conflicts in which we are now engaged. Fr. Pat wrote a marvelous article for the Catholic Herald while he was in Afghanistan this past year, so I know you are in store for a very special evening!
