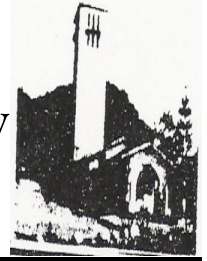

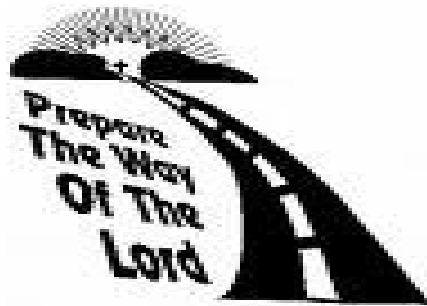
BAPTISM: Preparation class is necessary for parents and godparents. Class meets 3rd Wednesday of each month. Make an appointment with the priest for an interview and registration.
